#### **Summary**

The Lincoln-Omaha-Council Bluffs Association of Transportation Engineers (LOCATE) is a local chapter of the Missouri Valley section of ITE (MOVITE). The chapter membership is comprised of professionals in the each of its namesake cities. The chapter encourages participation of both public and private sector professionals involved in traffic engineering, roadway design, planning, and other transportation specialties.

The formation of LOCATE occurred seven years ago with a purpose of improving the traffic and transportation knowledge for its members and promoting the profession within our respective communities (amongst other things). Each year, the LOCATE chapter organizes and participates in various meetings, conferences, and community outreach opportunities to achieve these purposes, 2011 being no exception.

This year was the fourth year LOCATE members participated in the award winning Making a Difference (MAD) community service project. This year also saw LOCATE's co-sponsorship of the annual ASCE/LOCATE Transportation Conference held in Omaha for the fourth straight year. Another conference LOCATE helped sponsor in 2011 was the inaugural Heartland Active Transportation Summit (HATS). The Summit was organized by the Metropolitan Area Planning Agency (MAPA) to promote active modes of transportation such as cycling, walking, mass transit, etc. Other activities in 2011 included joint meetings with NSPE and the University of Nebraska ITE student chapter. #### Membership

The chapter membership numbers continue to hold steady in comparison to 2010. Continued participation in chapter meetings and other activities are maintained by rotating meeting locations through different cities within the region. This ensures all members have an opportunity to participate in a nearby chapter activity at some point during the year. The LOCATE chapter also continues to sustain a fair number of student and affiliate members. As of December 31, 2011, LOCATE membership totaled 128.

#### **Activities**

In 2011, the Chapter organized or participated in eight different events which included general meetings, conferences, golf outing and the annual meeting. Organizing and notifying members about Chapter activities were done electronically through the Chapter's website. Each of the events is described as follows:



• January 2011: The first of four general lunch meetings was held in Lincoln on January 19. Chad Blahak with the City of Lincoln presented information regarding the Lincoln Haymarket Arena project. The multi-million dollar project contained many challenges including the relocation of several railroad tracks, the state's first tandem roundabout system, and many others. (35 in attendance)

- March 2011: The second general meeting was held in Council Bluffs, Iowa on March 24. The
  meeting featured Mike Jackson with the Iowa DOT who discussed his involvement with Western
  Iowa ITS deployment project. This project was responsible for the planning and deployment of ITS
  infrastructure in Council Bluffs, Sioux City, and along I-29. (39 in attendance)
- April 2011: The annual LOCATE/ASCE Nebraska Chapter Transportation conference was held on April 15, at the Walter Scott Conference Center on the University of Nebraska-Omaha campus. The all day event featured speakers from around the area who discussed various topics and projects including diverging diamond interchanges, the Columbus Viaduct, City of Omaha College World Series (CWS) Improvements and many others. (Attendance: 150).
- May 2011: The 6<sup>th</sup> Annual LOCATE Golf Tournament was held on May 26 at Tregaron Golf Course in Bellevue, Nebraska. The tournament was a four-person, best ball competition with lunch and prizes. Approximately 23 members participated in the event.



August 2011: The third general meeting of 2011 was a joint meeting between LOCATE and the
University of Nebraska-Lincoln ITE student chapter. The meeting was held on August 31 on campus
at the newly refurbished Whittier Building. The meeting featured presentations from students on
current research and summer internship experiences. (24 LOCATE members in Attendance along
with approximately 10 students)





- September 2011: The second conference LOCATE help sponsor, promote and participate in was the inaugural Heartland Active Transportation Summit (HATS). The summit was held in Omaha on the University of Nebraska-Omaha campus and featured both a one day summit for professionals and a second day summit for members of the community. Each day included speakers and activities that covered different aspects of active transportation (i.e. cycling, walking, transit, etc.). The summit was organized by the Metropolitan Area Planning Agency (MAPA) and featured keynote speaker, Jim Oberstar. Approximately 200 people attended the professional summit on September 30.
- October 2011: The fourth general meeting of 2011 was a joint meeting LOCATE and the Nebraska Society of Professional Engineers (NSPE). The meeting was held in Omaha on October 25, and featured two speakers; Marty Grate with the City of Omaha and Dan Owens with Lamp Rynearson and Associates. The pair discussed their experiences with the Missouri River Flood, which occurred over the summer and the subsequent mitigation efforts they were involved in. (63 in Attendance)

 December 2011: The final event for 2011 was the LOCATE annual meeting which was held on December 9 in Ashland, Nebraska. The meeting was held in a similar format to the 2010 annual meeting, which was a lunch meeting in a relaxed atmosphere. The 2011 meeting featured reports from each board member along with an update from the Nebraska State Director for MOVITE, Mark Lutjeharms. The meeting also featured games and prizes for participants. Lastly, the results of the officer elections were announced and business for the year was adjourned. (32 in Attendance)

#### **Making a Difference Project**

This project was initiated in 2008 after the MOVITE president challenged local chapters to find ways to "make a difference" in their communities. In response, LOCATE developed an outreach program to educate local area high school students regarding safe choices when driving. The goal of the program is to discuss safe driving choices with teens that are either beginning to drive or have just begun driving. By introducing these topics to drivers at a young age, we hope to help them form good driving habits and raise their awareness regarding the various consequences associated with poor choices behind the wheel.

Currently, the program is run and maintained by volunteers within LOCATE. Mark Lutjeharms continues to organize MAD speaking engagements in Lincoln while Austin Yates coordinates things in the Omaha metro area. They also coordinate updates for the various topics, trends and other useful tools we communicate in our message to students. The content of the message is focused on making positive choices behind the wheel with regard to seat belt use, distractions, and impairment. Our presentations make use of data, facts, videos and activities to keep the audience's attention. In addition, these things are presented with an engineering "spin" to further distinguish the program from other safety presentation that they may hear.

Through these efforts the program continues to receive a warm reception by teachers, students and administrators. On many occasions, speakers received positive feedback from audience members and teachers including assurances that their behavior when driving will change as a result of the presentation.

On the heels of the program's success, professional societies in other states have begun to take notice. To be specific, the Texas ITE chapter (TexITE) and the Oklahoma Traffic Engineering Association (OTEA) contacted LOCATE in 2011 to learn more about our program. Subsequently, Mark Lutjeharms visited the interested groups and provided them with information about LOCATE's program. On April 28, 2011, Mark spoke to 135 attendees of the OTEA annual meeting, which was held at the Western Hills Guest Ranch in Sequoyah State park. He also spoke on September 15, 2011, during a Transportation Safety session of the TexITE annual meeting in Garland, Texas.

#### Leadership

#### **Board Activities**

Lastly, LOCATE's vice president, Matt Kruse was able to attend the spring MOVITE/MWITE joint meeting in Dubuque, Iowa and the ITE Annual Conference in St. Louis. The LOCATE board would like to thank MOVITE for sponsoring his trip and look forward to future opportunities to interact at the Section level.

#### **Finances**

The continuing philosophy of the Board is to fully support expenses through meeting income. This strategy has proven effective once again in 2011. Annual dues were used to support the other operations of the Chapter, such as providing free meeting attendance (including meals) for students. In addition, the funds raised at the golf outing were used to provide raffle prizes at the annual meeting. To properly account for these things, chapter finances were tracked and reported at each meeting. At the end of 2011, the Chapter's account balance was \$1,100.60. The final 2011 Treasurer's Report, listing total expenses, revenues and reserves, is included in the Appendix.

With the 2011 financial information, anticipated future expenses and income were estimated to develop a Chapter budget for 2012. The 2012 Budget will be approved by the Board of Direction in early 2012 and is included in the Appendix.
